- 1974 Choir formed; **Brian Mitchell** joins as accompanist; first piece performed in public at URC (St Andrew's)
- 1975 **Harold Miller** appointed Musical Director; **1st** full concert at URC; **1st** Feast Week concert; **1st** Penrice concert
- 1977 **'Song of Cornwall'** wins first 'Song for Cornwall' competition; Harold Miller depart for 2 years; **1st** concert outside Cornwall, Plymouth
- 1980 **100th** concert, Indian Queens; Harold Miller returns; **1st** recording (LP) – *Mevagissey Male Choir*; **Gibraltar** tour, 2 concerts
- 1981 *Song of Cornwall* wins competition organised by Bodmin Lions Club; **Wales** tour, 2 concerts; **1st** Truro Cathedral concert; **1st** Penrice concert
- 1983 **Holland/W Germany** tour, 3 concerts: **2nd** recording (LP); **Royal Albert Hall** 1000 Cornish voices concert
- 1984 **10th** anniversary concert, URC
